Over 1,500 Maryland National Guard personnel were deployed to Iraq in 2007. Altogether, almost 6,000 Maryland National Guard members have been called up since September 11, 2001. Their deployment caused financial harm and emotional suffering to their families and impaired our state's ability to respond to emergencies. The legal basis for sending the Guard to Iraq - the 2002 Authorization for the Use of Military Force - is no longer relevant; thus
Maryland no longer need send its Guard to Iraq.
